**Description:** In 2005, an NSF ATE project engaged with Juniper Networks to teach Juniper courses for the first time at a public school. That became the now global Juniper Networks Academic Alliance.

This group is now pioneering use of distance learning and remote equipment access technologies so a teacher at one college can simultaneously teach a Juniper course to students at many colleges, leveraging costly assets to maximize educational impact in difficult economic times.

This compelling session will demonstrate how this works in real time and serve as a powerful model of public/private partnership to cost-effectively impact technician education.
